RMCG is excited to have launched its redeveloped website and new-look brand for the business.

The updated website and branding marks the culmination of some invigorating changes to the business - including transferring the business structure from a partnership to a proprietary limited company, which occurred on 1 July 2016. As part of this change, an employee shareholder scheme was also introduced, widening the ownership of the business.
